TEN QUESTIONS TO ASK THE PARENTS OF AN ASPERGERS CHILD THAT IS NEW TO YOUR CLASS OR SCHOOL.

1. Is it just Aspergers or does the child have any other conditions you should be aware of?
2. Has your child been diagnosed with a learning problem?
3. Does your child have any sensory problems, eg loud noises, certain textures etc?
4. How do you handle bad behaviour?
5. How do you help your child move from one activity to another?
6. Do both of his parents live at home together or are there other arrangements?
7. What type of motivators do you use at home?
8. Does your child have a special interest?
9. Does your child have any special talents?
10. Does your child have friends in this class from another school (Pre School) or an outside school activity?
